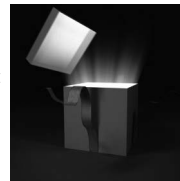

NEW CHURCHES BUBBLING UP...

Kia Ora Conference Family!

New churches bubbling up... on Sunday 14 August at the Church Planting School run by Dr Paul Siopo new church planters were commissioned to go and make disciples with the message, 'that wherever Jesus Christ is believed and received the church is planted'. During the four weeks of training they began to plant eight new churches! They will be given two years to bear fruit and then be considered for recognition by the conference.



By the way we now have 101 official churches, companies and groups in the conference!

Christchurch Offering. Thank you very much for giving generously to the special offering for our churches in Christchurch. Almost \$20,000 was raised. Let us keep praying for Christchurch as it rebuilds.

Children. How involved are our children in church? Most often our focus on them is limited to a story for the children during the worship service on Sabbath. Do we give these presentations less prep time than we would when addressing adults? There are specialized techniques and strategies that must be appreciated in order to plan child friendly services. I have found it very helpful to either observe or to spend time with a teacher who I am comfortable with and whose style, behaviour management and presentation methodology I find particularly helpful.
