This weekend is aimed at achieving the 4 NZQA unit standards towards your Pathfinder Leadership Award. To achieve this you must take part in a camp out scenario over the weekend. This means that you will be assessed on the following:

- Your camping equipment
- Camp set up
- Camp clean up
- Camp conduct
- Meal preparation etc.

Please ensure that you bring gear, food and equipment as if you were going on a 2 day tramp. The list below is a guide only and is the basic amount of gear expected.

- Tramping tent (can be shared between club members)
- Tramping style cooker (can be shared between club members)
- Warm clothing
- Hat
- Tramping boots/sturdy footwear
- Wet weather gear
- Cooking utensils
- Bible, pen, paper
- Enough food for 2 nights and 2 days. (tramping style food)
- Basic survival kit.
- Toiletries (soap, toothbrush towel etc.)
- Sleeping bag
- Sleeping mat (optional)

By the end of the weekend you should either have completed or be close to completing 4 NZQA unit standards at levels 2 and 3 for a total credit level of 18 credits.

Why PLA?

The Pathfinder Leadership Award is designed to train and equip Pathfinder Leaders. Areas covered include: Club organisation, presentation, camping and risk management skills and strategies, as well other administrative tools that will make the job of reaching young people for Jesus just that little bit easier. Added to this you get nationally recognised qualifications in the outdoors which can go towards achieving a certificate in outdoor recreation.
